

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO9216) affecting **1) Lower Street** from 120 metres northeast of its junction with The Loke to its junction with Mill Hill; **2) Lower Street / Slad Lane** from its junction with Mill Hill to its junction with The Street; and **3) Slad Lane / Horning Road** from its junction with The Street for 513 metres north-eastwards in the Parish of Salhouse to facilitate BDUK fibre cabling works, the Roads 1, 2 and 3 will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 17th to 21st March 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 2nd May 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates. Only one phased closure will be in operation at any one time.

Alternative route is via:

Phase 1: Lower Street, B1140 (Mill Road, Bell Lane), Vicarage Road, Upper Street.

Phase 2: The Street, Southfields Lane, B1140 (Low Road, Norwich Road, Mill Road), Lower Street.

Phase 3: The Street, Southfield Lane, Salhouse Road, South Walsham Road, Panxworth Road, Ranworth Road, School Hill, Common Lane, The Hill, Woodbastwick Road, Horning Road (South Walsham, Woodbastwick, Salhouse)

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A and B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 2nd May 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

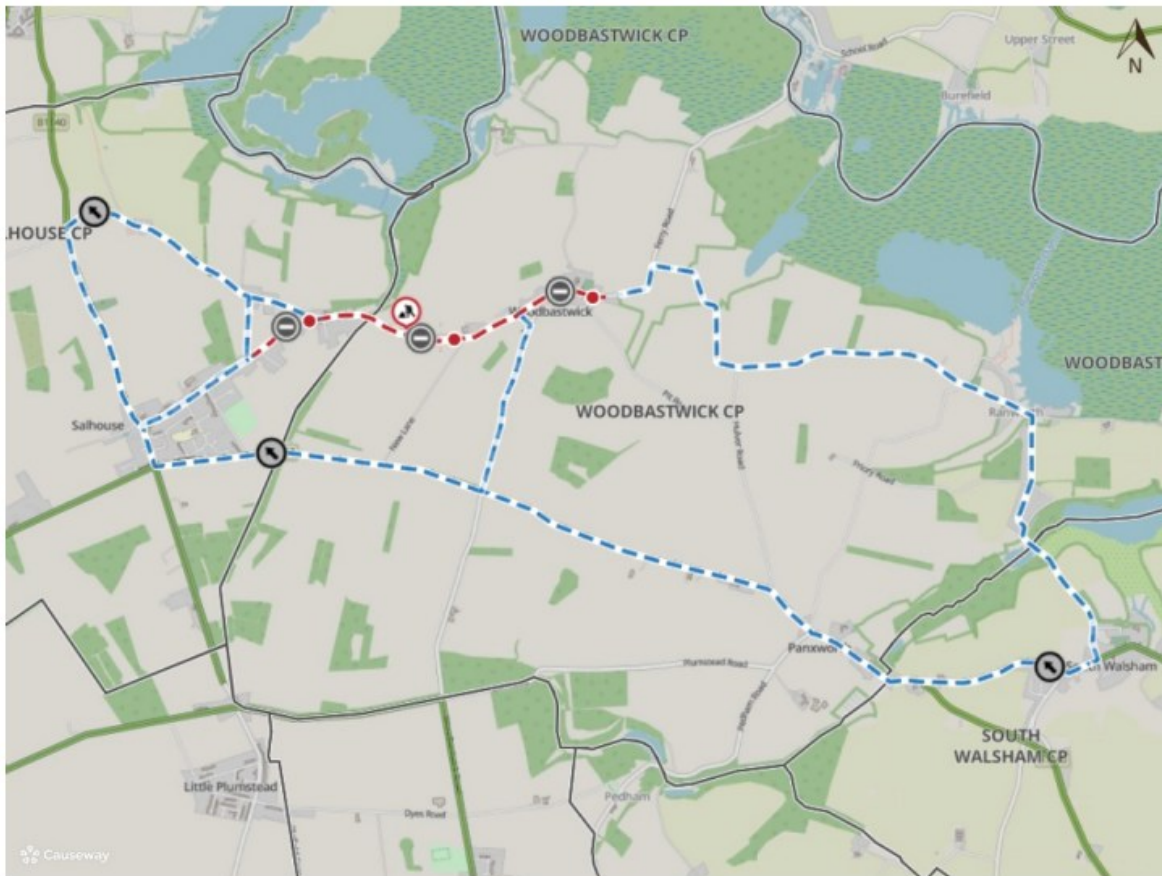
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
